**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2015-015**

**RECONSTITUTING AND REORGANIZING THE LOCAL LITERACY  
COORDINATING COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAGA, DEFINING ITS POWERS  
AND FUNCTIONS:**

**WHEREAS**, Section 1 of Article XIV of the 1987 Philippine Constitution states that, "The State shall protect and promote the right of all citizens to quality education at all levels, and shall take appropriate steps to make such education accessible to all";

**WHEREAS**, Section 1 of R.A. No. 10122 otherwise known as "AN ACT STRENGTHENING THE LITERACY COORDINATING COUNCIL BY AMENDING REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7165, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "AN ACT CREATING THE LITERACY COORDINATING COUNCIL, DEFINING ITS POWERS AND FUNCTIONS, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES" provides that:

"It is hereby declared to be the policy of the State to give the highest priority to the adoption of measures for the universalization of literacy. Toward this end, it shall encourage and rationalize the formulation of policies and the implementation of programs on non-formal, informal, and indigenous learning systems, as well as self-learning, independent and out-of-school study programs particularly those that respond to community needs.";

**WHEREAS**, to carry out the aforementioned mandate, R.A. No. 7165 or "AN ACT OF CREATING THE LITERACY COORDINATING COUNCIL, DEFINING ITS POWERS AND FUNCTIONS, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES" was enacted to be an inter-agency body administratively attached to the Department of Education, Culture and Sports;

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to create a group which shall implement activities pertinent to the City Government of Naga's thrust to ensure that every Nagueño is provided access to basic education and to achieve our national government's vision to eradicate illiteracy in the country;

**NOW THEREFORE, I, JOHN G. BONGAT**, Mayor of the City of Naga, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:

**Section 1. Creation.** In order to address the aforementioned points, the Literacy Coordinating Council of the City of Naga is hereby created and shall be known as the "Council".

**Section 2. Composition.** The Council shall be composed of the following:

- Representative, Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE)
- Representative, Philippine Information Agency (PIA)
- Representative, DILG
- Representative, National Anti-Poverty Commission (NAPC)
- Representative, Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA)
- Representative, Naga City Press Corps.
- Representative, the Naga City People's Council (NCPC)
- President, Naga City Out-of-School Youth Organization (NOSYO)
- President, Happy Youth Movement in Naga (HYMN),
- President, 4H Club Federation

**Section 3. Designation of the Local Literacy Coordination Council Focal Person.** The head of the Education, Scholarship and Sports Office (ESSO) is hereby designated as the focal person of the council.

**Section 4. Duties and Responsibilities.** The Council shall perform the following duties and responsibilities:

1. To act as the advisory and coordinating body of the City Government in the implementation of literacy programs of the Literacy Coordinating Council (LCC) and Department of Education (DepEd) in the local levels such as, but not limited to the "Abot Alam Program", an inter-agency literacy program in collaboration with the National Anti-Poverty Commission (NAPC), National Youth Commission (NYC), the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI), among others;



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2. To help the Literacy Coordinating Council (LCC) and the Department of Education (DepEd) in formulating strategies on how to reduce if not totally eradicate illiteracy in the City;
3. To assist LCC and DepEd in the information dissemination to support basic and functional literacy;
4. To promote the city's platform of H<sup>2</sup> ELP your CITY, a development agenda introduced to sustain the gains of past that defines and focuses on the following priority areas:
  - a. Health and nutrition
  - b. Housing and the urban poor
  - c. Education, arts, culture and sports development
  - d. Livelihood, employment/business and human/sectoral development
  - e. Peace and order and public safety
  - f. Cleanliness and environmental protection
  - g. Transparency, accountability and good governance
5. To perform such other functions as may be necessary in the furtherance of this Executive Order or as may be assigned by the City Mayor.

**Section 5. Separability Clause.** The provisions of this Executive Order are hereby deemed separable. If any provision thereof declared invalid or unconstitutional, it shall not affect other provisions which shall remain in full force and effect until revoked in writing by the undersigned.

**Section 6. Effectivity.** This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
