EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2015-022

CREATING THE NAGA CITY DRINKING WATER QUALITY MONITORING COMMITTEE (NCDWQMC), DEFINING ITS FUNCTIONS, COMPOSITION, AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

WHEREAS, Section 3.5 of the IRR of Chapter III Water Supply of PD 856 states that the local health authority shall establish a Water Surveillance Program through the creation of local drinking water quality monitoring committee;

WHEREAS, the code of sanitation of the Philippines (PD No.856) has prescribed the standards and procedures in ensuring water quality and it is imperative that the same be fully implemented the City of Naga;

WHEREAS, cognizant of the City Government of Naga's thrust to ensure the safety and welfare of the people, there is a need to create a group which main purpose is to oversee the operations and quality of all water supplies/systems within in the city;

NOW THEREFORE, I, JOHN G. BONGAT, Mayor of the City of Naga, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:

Section 1. Creation. In order to address the aforementioned points, the Naga City Drinking Water Quality Monitoring Committee (NCDWQMC) is hereby created.

Section 2. Composition. The NCDWQMC shall be composed of the following:

- City Mayor, as Chairman;
- City Health Officer, as Vice Chairman;
- SP Chairperson, Committee on Health, as Member;
- City Engineer, as Member;
- City Environment and Natural Resources Officer, as Member;
- Representative, Department of Health, as Member;
- Representative, Department of Environment and Natural Resources Office, as Member ;
- Representative, Metropolitan Naga Water District, as Member;

- All other private water suppliers within the City of Naga.

Section 3. Functions and Responsibilities. The NCDWQMC shall be responsible for the following:

- Regular collection/analysis of water samples;
- Evaluating laboratory results as to their compliance to standards;
- Conducting regular or immediate sanitary survey during the existence of potential cause of contamination;
- Instituting remedial measures to correct the deficiency of water supplies/systems;
- Informing the public of the latest quality of drinking water in the city;
- Performing such other functions related to water quality assurance.

Section 4. Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
