RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE PROFOUND SYMPATHY OF THE PEOPLE AND OFFICIALDOM OF THE CITY OF NAGA TO THE BEREAVED FAMILIES OF THE "FALLEN 44" OF THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE SPECIAL ACTION FORCE (PNP-SAF) AND SUPPORTING THE REQUESTS OF THEIR LOVED ONES FOR A COMPREHENSIVE AND SPEEDY INVESTIGATION ON THE BOTCHED OPERATION ON JANUARY 25, 2015 AT BARANGAY PIDSandAWAN, MAMASAPANO, MAGUINDANAO:-

WHEREAS, on January 25, 2015, the Philippine National Police Special Action Force (PNP-SAF) launched an operation, entitled Oplan Wolverine, at Barangay Pidsandawan, Mamasapano, Maguindanao to serve warrants of arrest to two high-profile international terrorists - Abdul Basit Usman and Zulkifli "Marwan" bin Hir;

WHEREAS, said operation purportedly resulted to the neutralization of Zulkifli "Marwan" Bin Hir, a bomb expert and high ranking terrorist, thereby saving millions of innocent lives around the globe;

WHEREAS, despite the significant military gain, the operation, however, also led to the loss of the lives of forty-four great men of the Philippine National Police Special Action Force;

WHEREAS, justice is also due to the Fallen 44 and the request of the bereaved families for a thorough and speedy investigation on the causalities of their deaths should be granted;

WHEREAS, the Board of Inquiry established by the Philippine National Police should ensure that no stone will be left unturned in its search for truth;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Jose A. Tuason and Hon. Vidal P. Castillo, unanimously seconded;

BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved to extend the profound sympathy of the people and officialdom of the City of Naga to the bereaved families of the Fallen 44 of the Philippine National Police Special Action Force;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to strongly express the support of the City of Naga to the requests of the beloved families of the Fallen 44 for a comprehensive and speedy investigation of the botched operation on January 25, 2015 at Barangay Pidsandawan, Mamasapano, Maguindanao.

LET COPIES of this resolution be furnished His Honor, the City Mayor, for his concurrence; Interior Secretary Manuel A. Roxas II, Justice Secretary Leila M. de Lima, AFP Chief-of-Staff Gregorio Pio P. Catapang Jr. and PNP Officer-in-Charge Leonardo A. Espina for their attention and appropriate action; and to the bereaved families of the Fallen 44 for their information and as a record for posterity.
